<u>ORDER</u>

Pursuant to the Connecticut Supreme Court's decision in the present case, Kerrigan v. Commissioner of Public Health, 289 Conn. 135 (2008), which was officially released on October 28, 2008, this Court hereby orders that:

1. Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment is granted;

- 2. To the extent that any statute, regulation, or common law rule in Connecticut is applied to prevent otherwise qualified individuals from marrying because they wish to marry someone of the same sex, this court declares that such statutes, regulations, and common law rules violate the Connecticut constitution for the reasons set forth in the Supreme Court's decision in this case;
- 3. The defendant Dorothy C. Bean, or her successor in office, shall issue marriage licenses to the Plaintiffs upon proper completion by the Plaintiffs of marriage license applications and shall record the marriages upon their celebration according to law; and
- 4. The Defendant State of Connecticut Department of Public Health shall take any and all steps necessary to effectuate the Court's declaration, including registering the Plaintiffs' marriages upon proper return.

This Order shall take effect on November 12, 2008.
