Fourteen paper copies of all briefs filed should be provided to the Clerk's Office no later than one business day after the electronic brief is filed.

The en banc hearing is scheduled for May 8, 2014 at 9:30 a.m., En Banc Courtroom, 7th Floor, John Joseph Moakley Courthouse, Boston, Massachusetts.
