

MA ELDER LAW BASICS

YOU HAVE RIGHTS

GUARDIANSHIP & CONSERVATORSHIP

You have a right to request a lawyer in guardianship or conservatorship cases. If you cannot afford one, Massachusetts should provide one for you.

You have a right to notice of any guardianship or conservatorship proceedings involving yourself.

Even if you are under guardianship, you still have freedom of religion and to your religious practice.

HEALTH CARE PROXY

You can designate who you want to make your health care decisions in case you are unable to make them. This is called a health care proxy.

POWER OF ATTORNEY

You can designate who you want to make your financial decisions in case you are unable to make them. This is called a power of attorney.

SAFETY & RESPECT

You have the right to be protected from discrimination on the basis of LGBTQ status in public accommodations like medical offices and hospitals.

SELF-IDENTIFICATION

You have the right to have your identity - including your LGBTQ identity - respected.

FACILITIES

You have the right to use restrooms and other gender-differentiated facilities consistent with your gender identity.
