TEXT-ONLY ORDER.

The parties are ordered to appear for a remote status conference at 10:00am on June 9, 2026 using the Zoom link on the Court's public website.

Absent a further order from this Court, Lucile Packard Children's Hospital (LPCH) shall not produce additional records to the government in response to specifications 12 to 14 of the May 6, 2026 grand jury subpoena issued to LPCH under the seal of the Northern District of Texas. *See FTC v. Dean Foods Co.*, 384 U.S. 597, 608 (1966) (holding that a court has "express authority under the All Writs Act to issue such temporary injunctions as may be necessary to protect its own jurisdiction"); *Protectmarriage.com-Yes on 8 v. Bowen*, 752 F.3d 827, 834 (9th Cir. 2014) (explaining that disclosure of information moots an action that seeks to prevent such disclosure).

For the same reasons, absent a further order from this Court, the government shall not take further action to enforce any grand jury subpoena seeking the private health information or patient records of any member of the putative class or subclass.
